Young Adult – 19 – 29 yrs May bring guests for activities or social events per the guest policy**	\$150. + \$19.50 hst	n/a
Adult 30 & up May bring guests for activities or social events per the guest policy**	\$190. + 24.70 hst	\$900.* paid over 3 yrs
Senior Social Membership – 65 yrs & up May participate in social events only May bring guests for social events only	\$125. + 16.25 hst	n/a
Family Membership - Includes children under 19 yrs - Includes a maximum of 2 adults - does not include grandchildren - To clarify, Family membership does NOT include children 19 yrs and older - May bring guests for activities or social events per the guest policy**	\$425. + 55.25 hst	\$900.* paid over 3 yrs
Camp membership - Includes children and/or grandchildren under 25 yrs - Includes a maximum of 2 adults - To clarify, Camp membership does NOT include children or grandchildren 25 yrs and older - May bring guests for social events or activities with no guest fee per the guest policy*	\$625. + 81.25 hst	\$900.* paid over 3 yrs

*Entrance fee:

- The Entrance Fee is waived for previous members at the discretion of the Executive

**Guest Policy:

1. A \$10. guest fee will be charged for non members taking part in an activity; eg. tennis, sailing, yoga, pilates, children's program etc.
2. Non members taking part in sailing or tennis **lessons** do not pay guest fees
3. There is no additional guest fee for guests at social/fundraising events; eg. Royal Hour, dance, fish fry, yachtion etc.
4. All activity and social guests must be sponsored and signed into the guest book by a member
5. The activity guest fee will be charged to the sponsoring member's account
6. Camp members do not pay guest fees but must sign guests into the guest book

For clarification:

- Guests may include family, friends or associates
- Guest fees may be waived for specific activities at the discretion of the Executive
- There is no guest fee for social events but guests must be signed into the guest book
